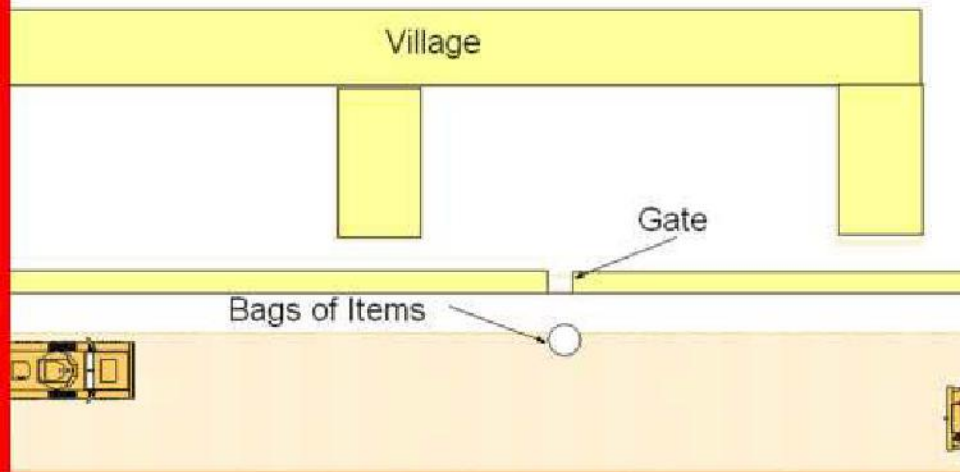

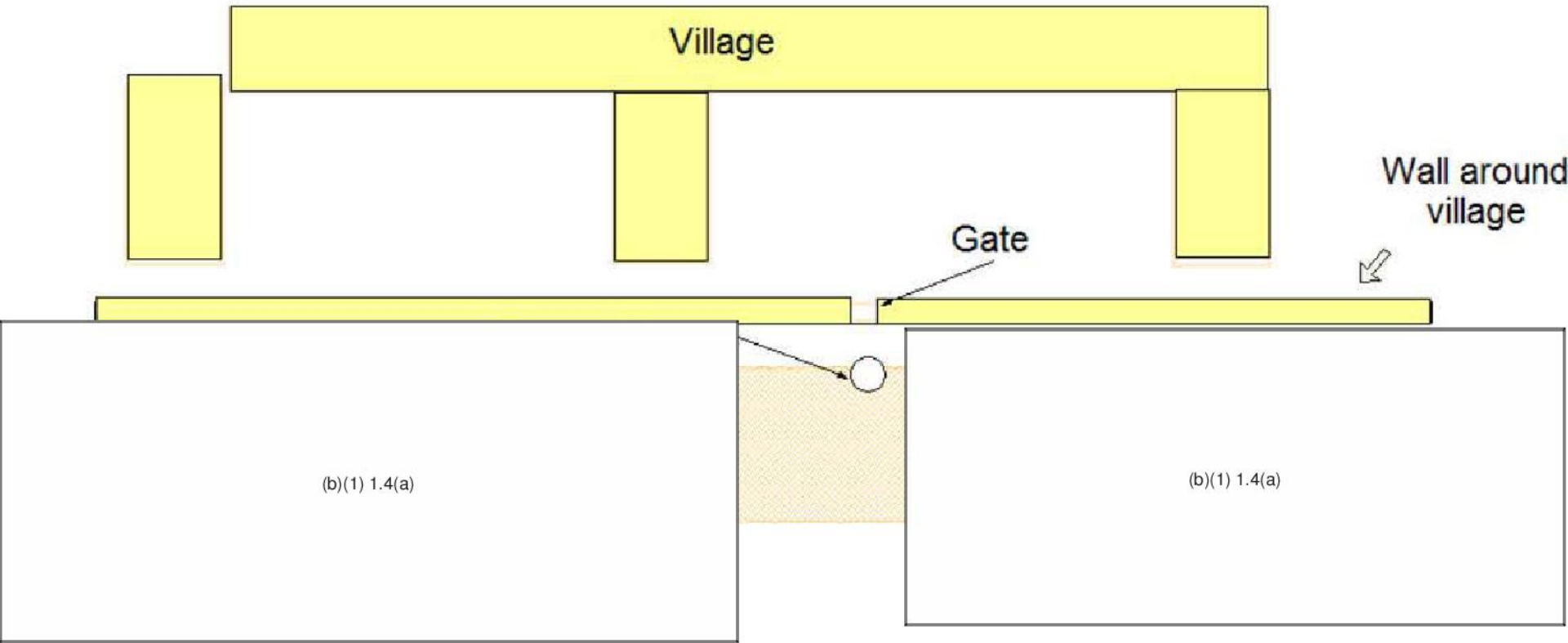
Team 2 requested to respond to a Cache IVO [REDACTED] (b)(1) 1.4(a). ISO Aggressor 6.

During construction operations, LN's dug up ERW's. Canadian Echo 6 requested EOD support. Canadians in the area brought the items out of the village and called Team 2 to inspect the condition of the munitions.

Team 2 arrived on scene and determined that the munitions were hazardous and the weapons were extremely rusted and falling apart. TL determined that the area was not suitable for disposal operations. Team transported the items to [REDACTED] (b)(1) 1.4(a) for disposal.

Items found included: 1x corroded 107mm rocket warhead with an empty rocket motor and no fuze (most likely Chinese type 63-2), 1x corroded 82mm mortar with no fuze (most likely Chinese HE 42-832), 45x 7.62 rounds, 1x Dshka, and approximately 3 feet of red detonating cord.
