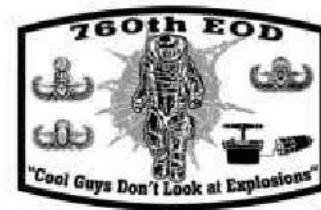

Additional Snapshot



211735MAY11 Team 1-1 responded to a Cache ISO Battle Company 1-32 IN BN IVO grid [REDACTED] Battle Company responded to do a BDA on an HME site that CAS had reported and engaged with 30mm.

Upon arriving on scene, patrol identified 29 x HME jugs and various other HME making materials in a nearby well house. Patrol cordoned the area and requested EOD support. Team 1-1 arrived on scene conducted 5's and 25's and established Safe Area at grid [REDACTED]

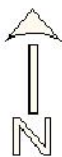
Once inside Team Leader identified the following:

- 29 x jugs of ANAL with an average weight of 25lbs per jug with det cord already primed in the openings
- 6 x 5 gallon cans of powdered aluminum
- 1 x 50 lb bag of powdered sugar
- 19 x improvised caps (non-electric blasting caps modified with small electric lights to make electric caps)
- 60 x small lights
- 2 x rolls of clear tape
- 10 x rolls of electrical tape
- 1 x 10' piece of white twin flex wire
- 1 x bottle of medicine appears to be cough syrup
- 2 x packs of pills appears to be cough medicine
- 1 x pocket knife

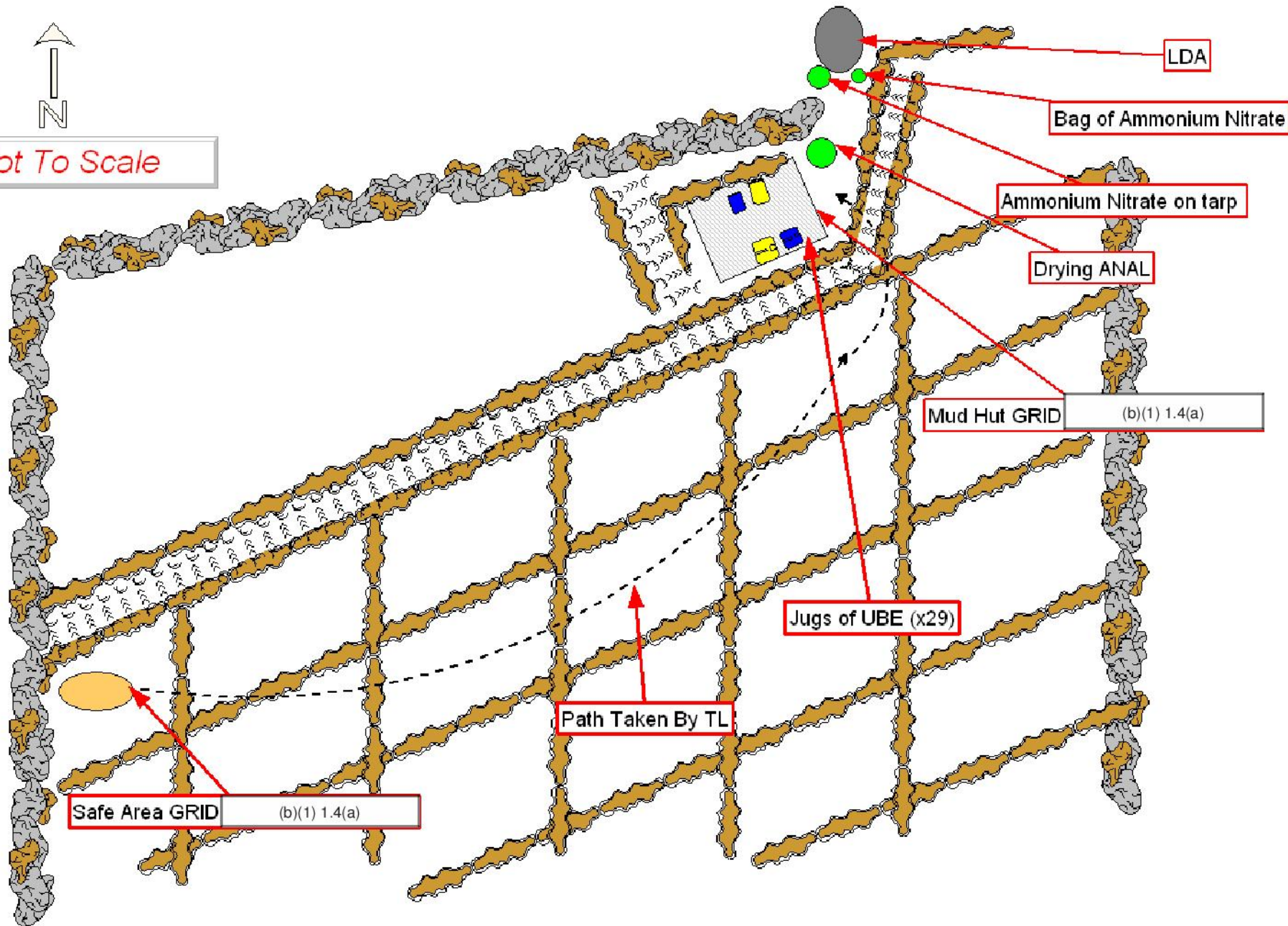
Team leader sweep around outside of well house and identified an additional 75 lbs of ANAL partially mixed on a tarp, and another 100 lbs of AN on a tarp. Team Leader identified another bag with 75 lbs of AN laying outside near a grape row. Team remote moved explosive hazards from well house consolidated with items outside and disposed of by controlled detonation (NEW 960 lbs).

Team Leader collected lights, rolls of tape, cough medicine, 4 sections of det cord, and 3 substance samples as evidence. No additional explosive hazards found MC [REDACTED]
