Additional Snapshot

On 232050LMAY11, TM 3-1 responded to a report of a jug of HME, ISO Dragon Slayer 3-1 IVO 41R QQ (b)(1) 1.4(a) EOD was notified that there was a small yellow jug partially buried next to a wall. EOD departed ACS4 at (b)(1) 1.4(a) Upon arrival EOD located suspicious jug. EOD (b)(1) 1.4(a) There were no wires or det cord protruding from the small jug. (b)(1) 1.4(a) EOD able to confirm that there was 7.62mm ammunition and no bulk explosive hazards, due to jug only being half filled. EOD deemed the scene safe and transported the jug back to a SHA at (b)(1) 1.4(a) Upon arrival at ACS4 at 0010, EOD safely dumped the contents.

Items inside the jug were:

- 1 x F-1 Grenade w/o fuze wrapped in cloth
- 287 x various 7.62mm ammunition
- 1 x Railroad spike
- 1 x Steel 90degree 3/4" pipe elbow
- 1 x Small plastic bag
- 1 x Cloth
